Who may audition?

Actors ages 6-18 are invited to audition. No previous experience is necessary.

Where and when the auditions?

Auditions are on Saturday, February 15, 10 AM - 12 NOON at the ARTS CENTER OF THE OZARKS, 214 S Main Street, Springdale, AR, 72764; Saturday, February 15, 1 PM - 4 PM at ARTS LIVE THEATRE, 818 North Sang Avenue, Fayetteville, AR 72701; Sunday, February 16, 2 PM - 5 PM at ARTS LIVE THEATRE, 818 North Sang Avenue, Fayetteville, AR 72701, AND Saturday, February 22, 10 AM - 2 PM at ARTS LIVE THEATRE, 818 North Sang Avenue, Fayetteville, AR 72701. No appointment is needed. Actors may drop in to audition during the audition times. Actors may choose from ONE of the above audition dates.

Who is the director?

Julie Gabel will be directing the production.

What will the audition consist of?

The audition will consist of readings from a script and the singing of a song of your choice acapella, (without accompaniment). Scenes will be available for study at the audition.

What is the director looking for?

Actors who create fun characters and have positive attitudes.

When are the performances?

Thursday, April 16, 7 pm; Friday, April 17, 7 pm; Saturday, April 18, 2pm & 7 pm; Sunday, April 19, 2 pm (closing performance). NOTE: It is *IMPORTANT ALL CONFLICTS BE LISTED ON THE AUDITION FORM*. Most conflicts are able to be accommodated. *Those who have conflicts April 12-19 will be unable to audition*.

What will be the rehearsal schedule?

Rehearsals will be scheduled after the auditions and after actor conflicts have been taken into account. Generally rehearsals will be a 4 times a week in the evenings starting around 6 pm or 6.30 pm and going no later than 8 or 8.30 pm. Rehearsals will increase as the production dates near. Not every actor will be called to every rehearsal. The cast meeting and read through will be within a week following the audition. There may also be a few Saturday rehearsals.

When is the participation fee due?

The participation fee of \$225 by Arts Live Theatre and is due at the first company meeting unless other arrangements have been made. Arts Live Theatre also offers a limited number of need-based scholarships. Information may be found at artslivetheatre.com. Payment plans are also available. The Participation Fee includes costumes and production tee shirt. The participation fee is to help cover production costs, which average \$12,000 for a musical.

Arts Live Theatre Audition

Thank you for auditioning for Arts Live Theatre! We are excited you are here and look forward to your audition! In order to foster a fun and professional environment, please follow these audition guidelines.

- 1. Complete the audition form neatly and legibly filling in all requested information.
- 2. Review the tentative rehearsal schedule and list *all conflicts* in the space provided on the audition form.
- 3. All actors, including previous ALT actors, must include a photo of themselves with the audition form. This does not have to be a professional head shot, but does need to be an actual photo. Forms without photos or those which are incomplete will need to be corrected before turning in to the audition monitor.
- 4. List prior applicable experience clearly and honestly.
- 5. Review scene material provided at the audition. For a musical audition, be prepared to sing a selection of your choice if requested. Usually 30-45 seconds is plenty.
- 6. Wait patiently and quietly for your opportunity to audition.
- 7. Arts Live Theatre professional staff will monitor auditions and be available for any questions.
- 8. During the audition, waiting actors will stay in Studio A in order to keep the halls clear.
- 9. Parents may watch an actor's audition if requested by the actor and approved by the director. Otherwise we ask parents to wait in Studio A for the actor to complete the audition.
- 10. To keep the noise level down and to prevent crowding, actors are asked to leave within 10 minutes of the audition.
- 11. An audition is a confidential matter for each actor. Refrain from quizzing an actor about the audition, unless the actor offers the information, as this can make an actor uncomfortable.
- 12. The cast list is normally posted to the ALT website and the ALT Facebook page within the week.
- 13. Each actor is invited to read once. There will be no call backs.

- 7. I will conduct myself in a professional manner at all times, respect the director and my fellow cast members and will not be a distraction during rehearsals.

Arts Live Theatre CODE OF CONDUCT & PLEDGE

- 1. I will not use inappropriate language.
- 2. I will respect other's personal space, no hitting or pushing or inappropriate physical contact.
- 3. I will be respectful of all ALT staff, artists, cast, crew and audience. I will be aware others may look up to me, so I will set a positive example and I will be a good leader and role model.
- 4. I recognize we are all different, physically, mentally and verbally. We each bring a unique set of talents and skills, and I will respect and value the contributions made by others in our group unconditionally.
- 5. I will respect our surroundings. In rehearsal space I am responsible for helping keeping Arts Live Theatre space tidy, throwing away my trash appropriately, and remembering to take my belongings home after every rehearsal. We all participate in cleaning up.
- 6. I will respect the buildings in which we perform. We are guests in these places, and must respect them accordingly: follow rules, keep spaces tidy, and stay in authorized locations within the buildings.
- 7. I will not use my cell phone cell, (including calling and texting) or hand held devices during rehearsals. It is disruptive and disrespectful to others. Cell phones may only be used in an emergency, for which I will notify the director who will call the parent.
- 8. I will be patient and understanding during the rehearsal process.
- 9. I will be prepared and attend rehearsals on time, bring my scripts, water bottles, and correct footwear (no flip flops or other open toed footwear).
- 10. I will take care of my fellow cast and crew and treat them as my theatre family.
- 11. I will refrain from bringing my personal life and issues to the stage.
- 12. I will not make negative comments about anyone or anything.
- 13. I will only post Executive Director-approved content about ALT programming on social media.
- 14. I understand bullying will NOT be tolerated at Arts Live Theatre. This includes commenting negatively on performance, dress, "trash talking", physical, forming cliques, and any form of intimidation.
- $15.\,\mathrm{I}$ will not significantly alter my appearance after casting in any way unless approved by the director.
- 16. I will report any bullying I see to the director.
- 17. Boys and girls may not be in each other's dressing rooms at any time.
- 18. Arts Live Theatre is a tobacco-free, drug-free and alcohol-free zone.

Consequences for violating the ALT Code of Conduct include but are not limited to requests for correction, verbal warnings, written incident reports, removal from current production, and/or suspension from future ALT programming and/or events. Please be kind, respectful and be aware of others. It is a privilege to be a part of Arts Live Theatre. At Arts Live Theatre we want to have fun in our classes, camps and productions, and in order to do this there must be some ground rules in place so we ALL feel accepted and comfortable. At Arts Live Theatre our programs are designed to be INCLUSIVE, and good behavior and respect towards others is paramount and is required for participation in Arts Live Theatre programming.
